An Idaho 8th grade student received this identification card from the Idaho Department of Labor a few months ago. As the child of a conservative family who is currently concerned about Common Core and the data sharing provisions that come with it, this student assures the parents that nothing was ever signed to request such a card. Neither did the parents give their consent to enroll their child in any program through the Idaho DOL. Needless to say that this 8th grader has never held a job, so they are left to suspect that the student's data must have made its way into the possession of the Idaho DOL through the student's existing school data via Idaho's State Longitudinal Data System. They are deeply concerned about this.
